Wounded Warrior Project® (WWP) is committed to helping injured veterans, like Lisa Crutch, achieve their highest ambition, no matter what that looks like.

When Lisa returned home from Iraq, she was a different person than before military service. Post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD) and a traumatic brain injury (TBI) caused her to forget joyous family memories. She also was battling with her transition as a female veteran from Sgt. Crutch to Lisa.

It was at a WWP event that she began to feel more like her old self. She felt comfortable and at ease — something that had been missing since she left the military — after meeting other female veterans at a Project Odyssey®. The program started with a five-day outdoor workshop where Lisa and the other warriors got to take a step back from everyday routines and focus on their mental health. Lisa also learned practical coping and communication skills that helped her to continue making changes once the program was over.

“Your donations take a lot of stress off the shoulders of so many warriors and their families,” said Lisa. “WWP can’t deliver these programs without your support. Things that you can’t purchase with money — your self-esteem, getting your life back — Wounded Warrior Project gives us. It took me many years to realize that I’m not going to be the Lisa I was before I left, but I believe I am a better Lisa today.”
